Curriculum Changes - The math and science departments have been looking into some potential changes for next year. Math is exploring getting more 9th grade students into Algebra and science is looking at giving 9th grade students a greater exposure to chemistry, biology and physics topics.

First Semester Academic Achievement -

We had our academic awards ceremony on Monday, Feb. 16 to recognize students who earned a 3.5 GPA or higher first semester. We had 92 students recognized with the following distribution:
