Consider Approval of Expenditures with ILA-BuyBoard Vendor Beynon Sports Surfaces

Background:

Beynon Sports Surfaces is a manufacturer and installer of synthetic all-weather running tracks. They are part of Tarkett Sports and are based in Hunt Valley, Maryland. Beynon Sports Surfaces manufactures three types of outdoor synthetic athletic tracks: spray coat, sandwich (multi-layer) and full-pour polyurethane. The increase of expenditures is for striping the running tracks at Clear Falls High School and Clear Springs High School along with the two long jump runways at Clear Springs High School. Patch work is also needed at Columbia Challenger Stadium. To date, \$98,000 has been encumbered. It is the recommendation of the Directors of Maintenance, Facility Services, and Purchasing to approve an authorization of expenditures with Beynon Sports Surfaces for an additional estimated \$250,000. Over 90% of these expenditures are projected to be 2023 Bond Funds. The new total estimated expenditure value with this vendor is approximately \$350,000 through August 31, 2026.
