## LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Middle School Community,

We have just finished the first trimester and I have many great things to share. Middle Schools are always full of energy. Some unfortunate schools are marked with negative energy, while others like ours burst with positive creativity. If you have made a visit to the middle school lately you will notice our message boards have been reimagined, we have a new honor roll clippership display, and our new mural highlights the wonderful collaboration between our school and the Oregon Coast Children's Theatre. None of this work would at all be possible if it weren't for the dedication of our staff and the buy in from our student body. They deserve the accolades for these accomplishments, and we all look forward to supporting more creativity here in the future.

During my last principal letter I highlighted our efforts to keep every member of the school community safe, and our preparation became useful here

recently. When the Rockaway Beach Police Department needed to close schools to contain an outside threat our protocols went into immediate effect. Parents were notified as soon as possible, and the school was put in lockout. Students stayed home while the police neutralized the threat, and we all felt gratitude that no one was hurt.

To continue this success we need parents and guardians to do a couple of things. First, sign up with our Flash Alert System through the district website. Navigate to the school closure tab through the "PARENTS" button on the main page. This will give you a text message or email informing you of school closure or emergency. Also, make sure your phone and email information is up-to-date with the school office, as we also send out a voicemail through our school messenger service. Finally, like us on Facebook if you have an account. You will receive a push notification from our

page in the event of a school closure or emergency.

With inclement weather expected over the next three months it is good practice that we are all communicating clearly to each other. Hopefully, we can be doing that at a band concert, basketball game, wrestling tournament, or after school STEM lab workshop and not in the event of an emergency. But in the event an emergency requires us to 'stick to the facts and get the word out' you are tuned in to our message through all available means.

I encourage parents and family members to continue supporting the great things we have going on here at the middle school. Your support is allowing us to participate in these amazing things. Thank you!

### IMPORTANT IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION

Oregon immunization requirements have changed. Parents, don't let your child get left behind! Note:Doses required vary by a child's age and how long ago they were vaccinated. Please check with your child's school or healthcare provider for details.

Oregon law requires the following shots for school attendance...

### A student entering grade six (6) needs:

- 5 Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
- 4 Polio
- 1 Varicella (chickenpox)
- 2 Measles
- 1 Mumps
- 1 Rubella
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 Hepatitis A



- A student entering grade seven through twelve (7-12) needs:
- 5 Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
- 1 Tdap
- 4 Polio
- 1 Varicella (chickenpox)
- 2 Measles
- 1 Mumps
- 1 Rubella
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 Hepatitis A (those entering 7th grade)



ATTENTION PARENTS! Our records indicate several students are in need of further vaccinations. For those students, we have enclosed a letter outlining what is needed. Please note: Students still out of compliance on exclusion day (2/17/16) will not be admitted to school.

Note: Beginning March 1, 2014, parents claiming non-medical exemptions will need to provide the school with Oregon Health Authority certificates of documentation. As more information about the new process becomes available, it will be posted at http://l.usa.gov/OregonSchool.
