FISCAL NOTE: Bond Funds

Background Information:

- A CFA (Community Facilities Agreement) is a document required by the City of Fort Worth to bind the development of a new site with required public improvements. This includes water, sewer, drainage and road improvements.
 - This CFA was signed as a part of the development of public utilities during the construction of Trinity Springs MS and Trinity Meadows IS.

Administrative Considerations:

- The City of Fort Worth has broadened their scope of work on the water and sewer portion of this CFA.
- This change in scope decreases the district's share of the cost and increases the city's share.
- The district's cost for water and sewer are decreased from \$208,692 to \$138,148 by this amendment.

The administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve the Amendment No. 1 to the Community Facilities Agreement (contract no. 32565) as presented.
