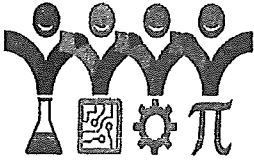

1. What is something you want to do for or with your students but cannot currently afford to do it?
I would like to have a classroom set of Ukuleles (14) for my general music classroom.
2. In 200 words or less, describe this project, listing individual items' estimated costs totaling up to \$600.

Ukeleles are a small, warm-sounding, string instruments that are just the right size for small hands. I teach general music to children Kinder- 5th grade, and Ukeleles would be a wonderful addition to my curriculum for all of the grades. Ukeleles would be a fun way to teach many musical concepts such as rhythm, melody, harmony, basic music theory, ear training for pitch, accompanying singing, and the encouragement a lifetime skill.

Each ukulele is \$39.00 if 12 or more are purchased. (Music in Motion Catalog)
Curriculum cost is about \$25.00


