- 1. The Scholastic Book Fair was a success due in part to our Coffee with the Principal held In Honor of Grandparents. Approximately 200 grandparents and grand-friends attended. Book purchases and attendance exceeded our expectations.
- 2. Fifth Graders attended a field trip to UT Tyler as part of a unit on career and college choices. Students investigated class choices for next year through persuasive writing.
- 3. Fourth Grade teachers attended a Writing Academy workshop which they will incorporate across the campus.
