Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the fourth grading cycle.

Objectives

- District wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 33 days

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 4 is 95.05%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for PK 91.80 % followed by EE grade 92.64%; 12th grade is 92.93% (lowest secondary).
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade, 96.17 followed by 4rd grade, 95.86%
- The 5th grade has had the highest attendance percentage each grading cycle.
