- Environmental Learning Plan - Does everyone know what data to collect?  
Evaluation methods 1.2, 2.2, and 4.2 will come from the MESS-E projects and we will work with that team to find out who will collect data from those 3 assessments.
- Messy Goals
  - Can we add the Salt watch to the water pollution project?  
Emily and Monique are working on organizing seminar and will make a final decision on where the salt watch will best fit. It will most likely be housed outside of the MESS-E project as a stand-alone for ease of use and promotion
