To qualify for this prestigious endorsement, students must complete the following seven components within their designated career pathway over the course of their four years at JTHS (visual on Page 2):

- 1. **Engage in two career exploration activities**, such as career fairs, job shadows, or guest speaker events.
- 2. **Complete two team-based challenges** developed in partnership with industry and academic collaborators, where students work together to solve authentic, real-world problems identified by professionals in the field.
- 3. Participate in a minimum 60-hour career development experience, such as an internship, clinical rotation, or similar hands-on opportunity.
- 4. Successfully complete at least two years of coursework aligned to their selected career pathway.
- 5. **Earn a minimum of six early college credits** related to the pathway, through dual credit, articulated credit, or Advanced Placement (AP) coursework.
- 6. **Demonstrate English readiness** through non-remedial placement via SAT/ACT scores, placement exam scores, dual credit, AP credit, or transitional course success.
- 7. **Demonstrate Math readiness** through non-remedial placement.


