Brian Weber, from Plante Moran Realpoint, and I would like to present and discuss the proposed purchase of LMC and Idea Factory furniture for Niji-Iro and Webster Elementary Schools at the Committee of the Whole Meeting on March 16, 2026.

Background

This project represents the final renovation phase for Niji-Iro and Webster under the 2021 Bond Program. The enclosed recommendation letter from Plante Moran Realpoint outlines the full scope and pricing. This phase focuses on replacing and installing new furniture for the Media Centers and Idea Factories at both schools.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve NBS Commercial Interiors of Troy, Michigan for the procurement and installation of furniture for the Media Centers and Idea Factories at Niji-Iro and Webster.

Proposed Costs

School	Cost
Niji-Iro	\$226,230.47
Webster	\$186,364.72

A project contingency of \$21,404.81 is included, bringing the total project cost to \$434,000, to be funded through the 2021 Bond Program.
