SUBJECT: Microsoft Operating System Proposal

Also note the resource for the annual subscription will be from the District's Technology Replacement Fund.

Subject: Microsoft Enterprise Agreement

To date the district has purchased Microsoft licenses on a per computer or server basis. For many years that has worked well for our district, except it did not allow for upgrades to newer versions of software. The district is at a point where it is time to consider moving to an enterprise agreement, where the licenses are an annual subscription based on staff FTE count for the following reasons:

- Currently Information Technology is supporting six different versions of the operating system and six different versions of Microsoft Office. This agreement would allow the district to keep the Microsoft software current on all Windows computers and servers. This would allow for the same versions to be installed on all devices. To upgrade the 5,000 individual licenses from Office 2007 to Office 2013 would cost \$258,050 (\$51.61 x 5,000 computers). We are not recommending this. In addition, to upgrade our current fleet of servers to the latest Microsoft Operating system would be approximately \$40,242 every 3-4 years, but would be included with a yearly subscription.
- Staff members, especially in the administrative area, are experiencing compatibility issues when sharing files with outside entities that are using the latest version of Office. By updating our Microsoft Office to version 2013 and beyond, we will have the latest version available at all times. We are currently limited to Microsoft Office 2007 or older on the majority of our computers.
- Windows XP will be out of support from Microsoft sometime after April 2014 and may no longer receive security upgrades. The current version of operating software is Windows 8.1 (we are 3 versions behind). The upgrade cost for our 5,000 computers would be \$244,700 (\$48.94 x 5,000). Again, we would avoid this cost by going with the Enterprise Agreement.
- All computers owned by LPS are covered in the annual subscription, so as we add
 more devices or replace devices they will automatically be licensed by moving to a
 subscription model based on staff FTE count.
- Provides a discount for students and staff to purchase Microsoft Office (for Windows or Mac) and/or the Microsoft Windows Operating System for home use. The cost would be approximately \$11-16 per license. The process would be administered through the vendor, whereas those with LPS email addresses (5th-12th grade students and faculty) would purchase the license from the vendor and the information is sent to their email.

The only disadvantage is that the Enterprise agreement is an annual subscription. If funding reductions occur and the district is no longer able to afford the subscription, we will be left without software on any of the Windows computers or servers.

The annual subscription amount for the Microsoft Enterprise agreement is \$81,495.27 based on 1500 FTE*. This is the REMC bid price, which meets the competitive bidding requirements. As a comparison, we obtained two additional quotes. One quote is the price of the Enterprise Agreement without the REMC price and it was \$104,327.99. The other was from another state/national contract and that quote was \$100,928.57.

Information Technology is recommending a 3 year contract, which would secure the pricing for 3 years at \$81,495.27 per year. It will be paid for from the Technology Replacement Budget.
