Board of Directors

- Number of Directors
 - Minimum of 3
- o Composition:
 - Parents, community members interested in DLVA, local business owners, professionals in the field of education, individuals with a background in digital technology, and representatives of the student body's demographics—all while striving for a balanced and diverse membership.
- Ex-Officio Directors (non-voting)
 - Charter School Principal
- Members nominate directors through a structured process to ensure a fair and transparent selection. Directors serve as the official governing body and voting members.
 - Directors are the official governing body and voting members.
 - Eligible nominators include:
 - Current Board Members
 - DLVA Parents and Guardians
 - Staff Members
 - External Organizations
 - The nomination process follows these steps:
 - A public notice announcing the nomination period will be posted on DLVA's website and newsletter.
 - Interested applicants must submit a letter of interest to the current DLVA board members.
 - The board reviews the candidates' qualifications.
 - The current board members select and vote on candidates for the board positions.

- 2 years
- o Reappointment okay
 - Yes
- o Number of Terms Limit
 - **2**
- o Re-election after hiatus okay?
 - Yes
- o Removal by:
 - 2/3 of all Directors for any reason
- o Regular meetings:
 - Monthly
- Special meetings:
 - Called by the President or 3 or more Directors
- o Quorum:
 - A simple majority of all Directors
 - All directors who are present at the monthly meeting.
- o Action by written consent:
 - Voting may be emailed with the approval of three of the four voting members.

Officers

- Officers may hold multiple positions simultaneously, such as Secretary and Treasurer.
- Term:
 - o 2 years
- Election cycle:
 - Every other year
- Removal by:
 - o 2/3 of all Directors for any reason
- Roles
 - o President
 - Vice-President
 - Secretary/Clerk
 - o Treasurer
- Committees
 - o Option as hoc committees, including at least one board member
 - o Executive Committee
 - o Academic Excellence Committee
 - Finance Committee
 - Contracts:
 - o The President is the person who may enter into contracts.
- Fiscal Year
 - Calendar year, or July 1 June 30 for schools
