Facilities Committee

- The Facilities Committee did not meet in March. Next meeting is scheduled for May 3, 2017.

Washington Water Main Break

- The water main break was repaired. Castle Concrete has been contacted again to get the stairs replaced, as well as the small piece of concrete by the building. They know the urgency of getting this all put back together, so I will stay on top of the schedule with them.

Window/Door Protection

Dr. Bill Beyers had contacted me about laminate covering for the doors/windows as an intruder deterrent. Ironically, I had just contacted a company in Missouri about a 3M glass covering that I had seen. Kyle Vanden Bosch with Midwest Glass Tinters came to Pana last week and did a walkthrough of the High School. He put together an estimate for all first floor glass doors and classroom windows, as well as the full panel glass sections on the first floor. We only walked the High School since it had the most first floor glass of all buildings. The estimate is attached. I have given Dr. Lett a couple of videos to show so that you can get the true affect of what this glass covering does to protect against shattering and intruders. Obviously, we don't have this type of project in our budget at this time, but I wanted to share for future planning.

TRANSPORTATION
