Description: Senate Bill 6 from the 82 <sup>nd</sup> Texas Legislature, First Called Session, 2011, created an instructional materials allotment for the purchase of instructional materials, technological equipment technology-related services. Each district and open-enrollment charter school is entitled to an allot	
The amount of allotment is determined biennially by the commissioner and is based on the legislar appropriation. Districts and open-enrollment charter schools have access to their allotment through educational materials ordering system known as EMAT.	
The district superintendent and the local board of trustees are required to certify that the district has instructional materials that cover all elements of the TEKS for the required curriculum, other than physical education, for each grade level, as required in the TEC, Section 28.002.	IS

28.002. IMA & TEKS Certification is brought annually to the Board for approval and recertificat	ion.
