## **Background Information:**

- In accordance with Board Policy CW (Local), the Keller ISD Administration is charged with selecting a committee to name new facilities in the district. For the past several years, the district has conducted this process, while also giving our students an opportunity to name their own new schools. The process provides an occasion for students and parents to meet with their new principal, and begin forging the relationships that will become the foundation for a new school community. It also gives the students a chance to be an integral part of the opening of their new school, and become a part of its history.
- In an effort to expedite this process for the 2006-07 school year, the Communications Department solicited parents to serve on a "Blue Ribbon" committee to create a ballot for the names of the new schools and choices for the new school colors. The committee was formed by an e-mail and campus solicitation of interested parents, and each person that served on the committee was selected through a random drawing. Each new campus had three representatives, and the committee met on March 7 to select a ballot.
- Following the committee's work, the ballots were then sent home with students on Monday, March 20, and were returned on March 24.

The following is the ballot that was sent home with students:

Colors: Forest Green and Gold Purple and Gold

Intermediate School Westwood Meadows Vista Meadows Trinity Meadows

Colors: Green and Gold Scarlet and Silver

Woodland Springs Elementary 2 Pioneer Trailview Independence

Colors: Blue and Orange Blue and Red

Vineyards Elementary Friendship North Tarrant Crossroads

Colors: Royal Blue and Silver Purple and Gold
