GEAR UP

The GEAR UP program partnered with Blackfeet Community College's Young Eagle Society (YES) program to expand career exposure opportunities for students at Browning High School.

Through this partnership, 20 Browning High School senior students participate in job shadowing and half-day employment experiences. These activities provide students with hands-on exposure to workplace environments and support informed exploration of career interests.

This initiative is integrated with the school's established dual credit and dual enrollment programming, reinforcing alignment between academic coursework and career exploration. The coordinated approach supports student skill development, workforce readiness, and informed postsecondary planning.

The GEAR UP spring semester calendar is fully scheduled with activities focused on postsecondary pathways, college and career readiness, and transition planning. Programming includes preparation for graduation-related events that support seniors in developing and finalizing their post-graduation plans.

The second semester also serves as a period for more intentional middle school services, with programming designed to strengthen early postsecondary awareness, academic readiness, and long-term planning.

The program continues to prioritize coordinated partnerships and intentional services that support successful transitions beyond high school and solidifying the mission of GEAR UP.
