 Safety Audits Must comply with Texas School Safety Center

Denton ISD-Safety Audit Information

Since 2005, all Denton ISD buildings have been on a rotation for safety audits. The audits were developed by the Texas School Safety Center. As a biproduct of these audits, improvements have been made in the overall safety of campuses and the district. These audits have continued this school year.

Improvements Due to District Audits

- Improved campus Emergency Operation Plans
- Increased interaction with local law enforcement
- Improved campus visitor procedures
- Numbering of all exterior doors inside and outside

- Card access systems at all campuses
- Increased camera coverage
- Increased secured entrances to early childhood, elementary, middle school and high school campuses
- Increased emphasis on lockdown drills; standardizing procedure district-wide

Senate Bill 11 Threat Assessment

Legislation

Each district must establish a threat assessment process and safe and supportive school to team which will establish procedures.

District Response

- Threat Assessments will be completed by campus Building Emergency Response Teams (BERT) and amended for compliance with TEA
- Threat Assessment Training has been provided for designated District BERT representatives from each campus

Senate Bill 11-Safety Planning

Legislation

• Emergency Operations Plan must address all employees including substitutes

District Response

 Implementation of Standard Response Protocol or SRP, with training at the district level and campus level

Spring 2019-Standard Response Protocol Training

Substitutes will be provided with training through ESS and campus BERT teams will assist substitutes with the nuances of each campus.


