RE: Appointment of Legal Counsel – Intervention for Tax Objections
DATE: September 28, 2010

In October 2006, the Board of Education adopted a formal resolution appointing Franczek Sullivan P.C. to intervene, on behalf of District 97, with tax rate objections for tax years 2001, 2002 and 2003. In October 2009, since the District's current legal counsel -- Hodges, Loizzi, Eisenhammer, Rodick & Kohn -- likewise provided these same services, the Board of Education appointed same and adopted the attached resolution for tax years 2003 and 2004. At that time we indicated that at appropriate times, and, as directed by legal counsel, we may need to continue to update this formal resolution for outlying tax years.
