This memo formally requests the Board's approval for a full-day professional development (PD) session on the educational software Formative, scheduled for January 5, 2026, at a total cost of \$4,200.

## **Rationale and Impact**

This PD is a direct response to high demand from our educators. Feedback from the past two professional development sessions identified additional Formative training as one of the top requests. This software is valuable because it can be utilized across all curricular areas for immediate and effective measurement of student understanding.

## **Key Outcomes for Educators**

This session is designed to equip our 6th-12th grade educators with critical skills, resulting in the following specific outcomes:

- **Interactive Assessment:** Educators will gain a deeper understanding of how to use Formative interactively during lessons to quickly assess student understanding.
- **Targeted Intervention:** Training will cover how to use Formative's reports to identify and address specific learning needs of students in their classes.
- Collaborative Practice: Educators will learn to use the reporting features to work collaboratively, supporting one another to better meet overall student learning needs.

Time will be allocated during the session for educators to apply the concepts presented and integrate them into their planning. We believe this targeted training will significantly enhance our teachers' capacity for real-time student assessment and data-driven instruction.
