The kids will camp out with their parents and have a very big picnic. We will have a bon fire at night on Saturday with smores if weather permits. Sunday morning breakfast and an egg drop off a 105 ft tower that Mr. T climbs, tractor rides, and jumping in the corn rounds out the trip. People head home Sunday AM.**

**How it is funded: The trip is funded by students and their families.**

**Transportation: Students are transported from WW to my parent's farm by their parents or parents that have chosen to carpool.**
