PANA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL AND PANA HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS MEDICINE CONTRACT

Pana Community Hospital and Pana High School hereby engage in the following contract for the 2021 - 2022 school year.

Services will be provided by Pana Community Hospitals Certified Athletic Trainer for all home and away varsity and junior varsity football games, all home freshman football games, the Pana Invite volleyball tournament and/or Pana/Shelbyville Invite volleyball tourney, all home girls and boys varsity basketball games along with any postseason games that AD deems necessary, Girls Thanksgiving basketball tournament, the Pana Co-Ed Track Invitational, and any conference or sectional track meet that is hosted by PHS. Services will include:

- > Certified Athletic Trainer
- Medical supplies as recommended by professional staff.
- > Provision of care and/or treatment within the scope of practice by the licensed professional as directed and necessary to any injured player, coach or official.
- > Pre-game taping/preparation and post-game icing and follow-up.
- Scheduled sports medicine services to injured players on an as needed basis by physician referral.
- > Scheduled taping clinics for coaches for pre-practice taping instruction.
- > Supervision of return to play by the licensed Athletic Trainer that will be supported by the coaching staff of Pana High School.

This contractual agreement stipulates that Pana Unit #8 will pay an annual fee of \$3,500 with estimated total hours of coverage of 200 - 250 hours. The school will be invoiced 9-1-21 and 2-1-22 for bi-annual payments. If there is any change to the sports schedule due to Covid-19 then a restructured contract will be done for fee for service if above hours aren't estimated to be reached. A free weekly sports clinic will continue to be offered two times a week at the school.
