Kendra	Removed from student access	Removed (Objective Committee)	Remove	The Appeal Committee determined that the book contains Objective Sensitive Material as defined in Utah Law [it contains a description or depiction of content listed in Utah Code Ann. §76-10-1227(1)(a)(i),(ii) or (iii)]. Therefore, Utah law requires the book be removed from the school setting.
Romeo and/or Juliet: A Chooseable-Path Adventure	Removed from student access	Removed (Objective Committee)	Remove	The Appeal Committee determined that the book contains objective sensitive material as defined in Utah Law [it contains a description or depiction of content listed in Utah Code Ann. §76-10-1227(1)(a)(i),(ii) or (iii)]. The text of the book directs readers to visit a website as part of the story. If the website's content were included in the book – the book would violate Utah's sensitive materials law. In addition to the linked website, the text printed in the book includes a description of sexual intercourse or sodomy. Regardless of whether the inclusion of the website is considered, this passage violates the objective criteria in Utah's sensitive materials law, and the book should be removed.
