SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Netsync Network Solutions in the amount of \$709,433.37 for the purchase of the technology infrastructure for the Cheek Middle School campus.

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

This equipment provides the networking electronics, including switches and wireless access points for the campus.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

This fiber and installation will be purchased through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (DIR). This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by this project's 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and arrange for delivery & installation in time to coordinate with the construction timeline.
