23996 Discussion of Board Student Outcome Goal 1 and Goal Progress Measure

<u>1-1</u>: Director of Accountability, Assessment and School Improvement Annette Macias provided Trustees with data for the eight schools currently rated Improvement Required. In the standards-based assessment that was given earlier this month Noel and Pease showed growth, Downing and Bonham Middle School were holding steady, and Zavala, Blackshear, Goliad, and Ector Middle School lagged behind the targets. The district will give another assessment in February.

The school board's Outcome Goal 1 is to have no IR schools by the start of the 2019-2020 school year; and the Goal Progress Measure 1-1 is to have no six-year IR campuses by the end of this school year 2017-2018. (This item was moved to be heard first on the agenda.) [6:10 - 6:35 p.m.]

23997 Discussion of Board Constraint 1 and Constraint Progress Measure 1-1:

Trustees discussed Board Constraint 1 and Constraint Progress Measure 1-1. Constraint 1, states the Superintendent shall not allow a campus to remain in IR status for more than four years without a restart plan. Constraint Progress Measure 1-1 states the Superintendent will have restart plans developed for Ector MS, Zavala Elementary, and Noel Elementary this month. All three schools are in their 5th year of IR status.

The STEM Academies at Ector and Zavala in partnership with the University of Texas of the Permian Basin are one option, district leaders are considering

other ideas as well. Board president Carol Gregg reminded the group of deadlines quickly approaching (March 1) to enter agreements with potential partners. [7:44 -7:52 p.m.]

<u>Discussion of Board Self Evaluation</u>: Trustees discussed their self-evaluation. Texas Education Agency Deputy Commissioner of Governance A.J. Crabill (via Skype) and Region 18 Leadership Consultant Larry Lee joined this discussion to help guide the Trustees through this evaluation of their work. Trustees used score sheets and the Texas Framework rubric to score nine domains. Each Trustee scored the group's work on its goals, outcomes and progress. Of a possible score of 100 the Trustees have a score of 25.
