SUBJECT: Review and reaffirmation of the Wharton County Junior College Mission Statement.

RECOMMENDATION: The WCJC Board of Trustees should review and reaffirm the WCJC Mission Statement on a biannual basis in keeping with the process established by the WCJC Administration for assuring compliance with SACSCOC Section 2, *Mission*.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE: As part of the decennial Reaffirmation of Accreditation with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), the Wharton County Junior College (WCJC) administration developed a schedule for the review and approval of the WCJC Mission by the WCJC Board of Trustees. Review and approval of the WCJC Mission is critical to ensuring compliance with SACSCOC Section 2, *Mission*, which states:

A clearly defined and comprehensive mission guides the public's perception of the institution. It conveys a sense of the institution's uniqueness and identifies the qualities, characteristics, and values that define its role and distinctiveness within the diverse higher education community. Fundamental to the structure of an institution's effectiveness, the mission reflects a clear understanding of the institution by its governing board, administration, faculty, students, staff, and all constituents.


