Board Report
November 2023

Kindergarten has been working on learning numbers to 10 by counting, answering “How many questions?”, matching the numeral to the number of objects, and learning the succession of numbers. First grade has been focusing on sums and differences to 10, understanding relationships and connections between different addition facts, and using both 5-group cards and number paths to solve subtraction problems.

In writing, K-1 has been learning about sentence structure along with what nouns are. They learned about fiction vs. nonfiction texts and how that relates to writing.

In Kindergarten, students learn to recognize letters and associate the sound with the letter, along with many phonological awareness skills. First grade has also been learning about long vowels and phonological awareness skills. For ELA, both grades are focusing on listening comprehension and vocabulary.

One area that we have been focusing on this year is SEL. SEL is a daily focus for our classroom this year. We do this through discussions, games, books, and videos.

Third grade students are working on multiplication, the 4th grade has been working on multiplying multiples of 10, 100, and 1000, and the 6th graders are working on equivalent algebraic expressions. In Science we are studying the human body system. In Social Studies the 3-4 are learning about our environment, and the 6th are learning about the Age of Exploration.
