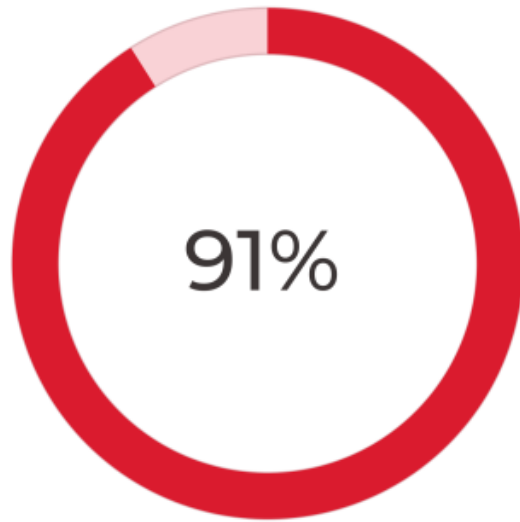
Program Growth & Impact: A 3-Year Comparison

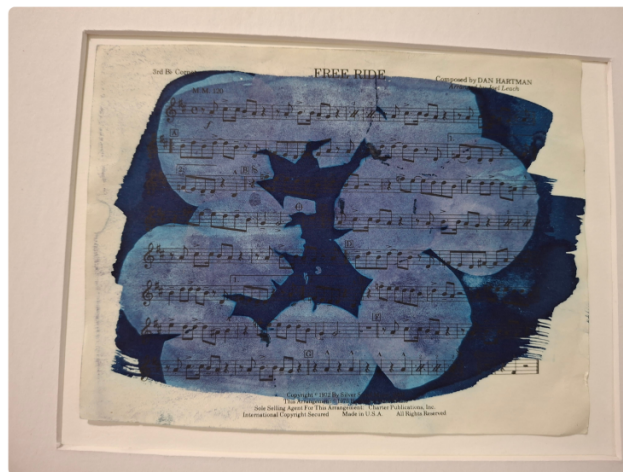
