Minidoka County School District Food Service Report February 2020

Howdy guys,

For the month of February, we served 18,734 breakfast meals for an average of 1,041 per day. Last year we served 17,671 for an average of 1,040. You can see that our breakfast numbers are the same as last year. There is a higher number of meals served in 2020 because we served 18 days compared to 17 days last year.

For lunch we served 48,231 meals for an average of 2,680 per day. Last year we served 45,100 for an average of 2,542 per day. Again our numbers are very close to last years. We are showing a small increase of 38 meals per day.

We have a food broker coming to see us with some new food items that have come out for schools since the first of the year. He will be here on Thursday March 12th. We always look forward to finding new items that the students might like.

Our reimbursement for February 2020 is \$158,037.24 and last years was \$142,127.43.

We will be starting our application process for our summer food program this month. We will be doing Lunch in the Park, Summer School and Migrant School again this year.

We are also going to be hiring a new full time cook for West Minico before spring break.
