This item requests approval of the quote from College Board in the amount of \$192,244.68 for College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) through the administration of the SAT Suite of Assessments.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The contract was previously approved in June 2021.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Denton ISD participates in the SAT Suite of Assessments to promote college readiness for all students. Under HB3, the District anticipates receiving a refund of testing in the amount of \$100,971.00.
