

Local Option Levy Discussion

Policy Issue/Situation

The current five-year local option levy will expire in 2018. The 2017-2018 proposed budget includes the fifth year funding of approximately \$30 million. This funding has enabled the district to fund approximately 300 teachers to reduce class size. The School Board is the authorizing body for an election, so discussion and preparation are key to a successful outcome next May 2018.
