TITLE: Report on American Heart Association Kids Heart Challenge

BACKGROUND:

The American Heart Association's Kids Heart Challenge is an enduring tradition in the Amphitheater School District. Since 1989, students in the District have raised over \$600,000 dollars for heart disease research and prevention.

Through the participation of eleven schools during the 2022-2023 school year, our District raised \$36,750.00 for the American Heart Association and 546 families learned Hands Only CPR. Just as important as the benefits of the fundraising, however, is the benefit to our participating students, who learn the importance of proper nutrition, exercise and living tobacco-free lives. We are so proud of Amphitheater being one of the top fundraising districts in Southern Arizona.

We are excited to continue in this partnership with the American Heart Association and thank you to all who come together to help children learn about their health and the benefits of giving to others.
