Field Trips from 11/1/25 through 11/22/25

Successfully processed 84 field trips, utilizing a total of 127 vehicles — including 66 buses and 61 vehicles from our Auxiliary Fleet. We provided 52 drivers to cover these trips.

Transportation uses a bidding system to assign drivers for available field trips. Drivers earn points based on attendance—one point for each day they work, plus a 5-point bonus for perfect attendance throughout the week. We sent a driver down to the state band trip for the band trailer and box truck. We also had the privilege of annual O.P. Norman JH pep rally with all of the students from Helen Edwards.
