Re: Chromebook Replacement

As a result of discussions with Administration and Cabinet, the Information Technology Department is recommending the replacement of the Chromebooks from the 2013 Bond fund.

The recommendation is to replace approximately 3,800 Chromebooks across all our buildings. The cost of this project is not to exceed \$1,600,000, which will include the purchase of new Chromebooks, charging carts, and rewiring of carts currently owned by the District.

The recommendation is to award the contract to Presidio, Inc. The purchase will be made from the 2013 technology bond budget using the State of Michigan's REMC Save Bid Project. Because we are utilizing pricing from this REMC bid, no additional bids are required.
