NSBSD Strategic Plan Goal:

2.0 Community Engagement: Foster collective responsibility, commitment, and trust between the school and community.

2.1 Communication: Advance on-going 2-way communication, participation and interaction within the school and between the school and community, building the bridge of trust.

NSBSD Policy Manual:

Board Bylaw 9140, Board Representatives: The Board may appoint any of its members to serve on advisory committees or as its representative to other public agencies or organizations when the Board deems such appointments desirable, contingent on acceptance by the member.

Issue Summary:

The North Slope Borough School District Board of Education received an invitation three years ago to appoint the President as the NSBSD Representative to the Voice of the Arctic Iñupiat Board of Directors. This appointment automatically designates the President to serve so long as they are still a member of the Board of Education and until his/her successor has been appointed and qualified.

Background:

From this appointment, the Board of Education must annually adopt a resolution expressing its commitment to the Voice of the Arctic Corporation and its intention to remain a voting member. This resolution must be provided to the Voice of the Arctic no later than January 31 of each year.

Proposed Motion:

“I move that the NSBSD Board of Education adopt Resolution 23-03 and appoint the Board President to the NSBSD Seat on the Voice of the Arctic Iñupiat Board of Directors and to serve until their successor has been appointed and qualified.
