### News/Notes

- The 2024-2025 Ranger Athletics is officially finished and we will soon be starting to look ahead to the 2025-2026 School Year but once again the Spring Sports Season created some wonderful results.

### Athletics Updates

#### **Baseball**

- The Ranger Baseball team finished with an 8-11 Regular Season record and a 6-7 Great River Conference Record. Kyle Spencer and Keyon Wesner were named to the GRC All-Conference team for 2025. They entered the Section 7AA Tournament as the #9 seed and defeated Moose Lake/Willow River 9-8 in the 1st Round. They lost to the #2 seed Esko in the 2nd Round and then Mora 6-4 in the Elimination Round to finish their season. It was a positive season for the Rangers and they have many Varsity starters returning for the 2026 campaign.

#### **Boys Golf**

- The Crosby-Ironton/Aitkin Boys Golf team finished 6th overall at the Section 6AA Championships, only 4 strokes away from 5th overall. Louie Meyer played great in the Tournament qualifying for the Second Day and giving him an opportunity to qualify for the State. He finished 25th overall but was only 6 strokes from being in the Top 10 and will be looking to improve on that next year. The team was also chosen as an All-Academic team for Section 6AA.

#### **Girls Golf**

- CIA Girls Golf team finished in 12th at the Section 6AA Tournament where their top performers were Svea Johnson and Taya Mohs. The team overall was very young with no Seniors on the Section Team so they will be looking to improve on that standing next year.

#### **Softball**

- The Softball team finished up their regular season 3-16 on the year. Unfortunately due to injury and other circumstances they were unable to play in the Section 7AA Tournament. Rayne Avelsgard was named to the Great River All-Conference team.

#### **Track & Field**

- The Track & Field team completed their 2025 campaign at the State Championships on June 10th & 11th. 11 total Rangers competed at State after qualifying at the Section 7A Championship where they won two Section Championships (AJ Westin-800m & Girls 4x800m) and had three Section Runner-Up who also qualified for State (Lucy Lewandowski-Pole Vault, Girls 4x400m, Boys 4x100m). Both Boys & Girls teams were awarded Academic All-State status and five individuals were named Academic All-State as well.
