Winter sports season are entering crunch time. The girls play Weiser tonight to advance to the 2nd place game for the district tourney. If they win that game they will go to state as the number two seed from the SRV. The boys have their final regular season game this Friday at Fruitland.

Girls Basketball- The varsity girls had a rough stretch from the middle of December to the middle of January. With some key injuries getting healed up they are playing their best basketball of the year at the right time. They beat Payette in the play-in game and lost a close game to Parma in the semifinals. Both the JV and Frosh/Soph teams won their respective sub-varsity district tourneys. That tourney was hosted here at HHS. The girls' state tourney is held at Middleton High School February 16-18.

Boys basketball- The boys program is struggling at all levels right now. Our youth and inexperience is showing through. Coach Mann sees a lot of potential in years to come. In league play the varsity is 0-7, JV is 1-6, and the frosh are 4-3. Their district tourneys start next week.

Wrestling- The wrestling team has shown improvement throughout the season. Coach Levinski is working hard to get his kids ready for the district tourney coming up on February 18th. The kids are showing a true excitement for the program. Their final regular season match is Feb. 8th @ New Plymouth. After that they will be getting ready for Districts. The state tourney is held this year at the Ford Idaho Center February 24-25.
