Facts of this Matter:

Zionsville Community High School has worked with the same photography provider since before 2010. As we did for the elementary schools in 2024, the Leadership Team would like to engage in a Request for Proposals (RFP) process to test the current market for these services and to be sure that our students and families are receiving the best service and competitive pricing as possible. We have valued a productive relationship with the current local provider and hope that they will participate in this process, but would like to explore additional options have emerged in the market since this was last examined over a decade ago.
