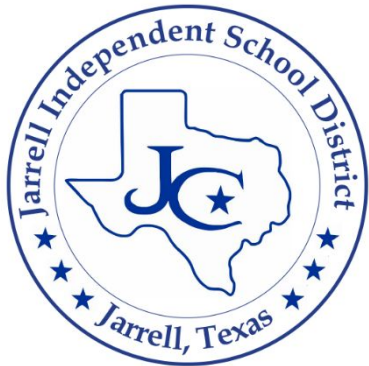

Goal 1 (Reading)

Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students who score Master's level performance on STAAR Reading from 17% to 52% by December 31, 2027.

Goal 2 (Math)

Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students who score Master's level performance on STAAR Math from 2% to 39% by December 31, 2027.

Goal 3 (CCMR)

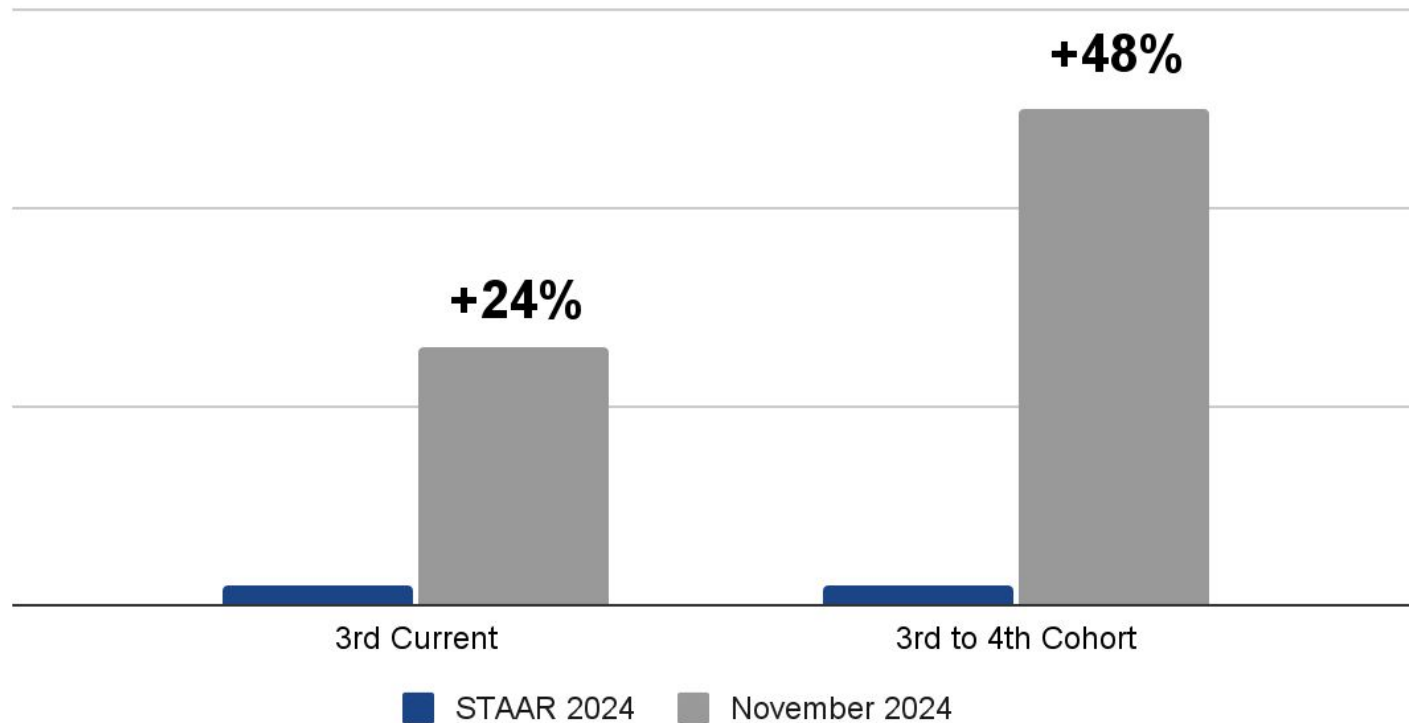
The percentage of graduates who meet the raw score criteria for CCMR will increase from 49% to 69% by December 31, 2027.

Goal 1 (Reading)

Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students who score Master's level performance on STAAR Reading from 17% to 52% by Dec. 31, 2027.

GPM 1.2: The percentage of Kindergarten - 2nd-grade students meeting the literacy composite benchmark will increase from 40% to 70%.

Students Scoring Above 5



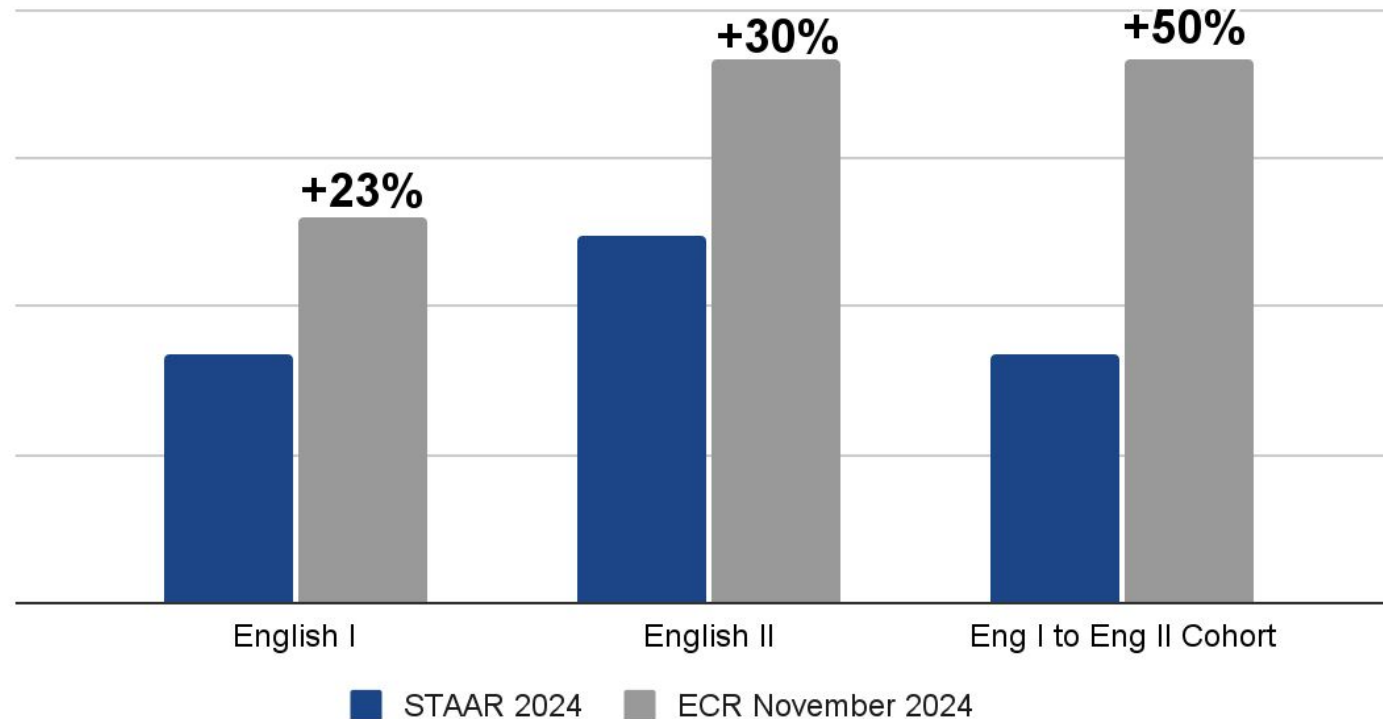
Goal 3 (CCMR)

The percentage of graduates who meet the raw score criteria for CCMR will increase from 49% to 69% by December 31, 2027

GPM 3.2: The percentage of students meeting criterion score on an AP exam will increase from 6% to 40% by 2027.

GPM 3.3: The percentage of students meeting TSI criteria in both reading and math will increase from 27% to 45% by 2027.

Extended Constructed Response

Areas of Support

- Professional development for teachers
 - How to respond to the ECR data?
 - Individualized lessons based on student response
- Students writing daily in all classrooms
 - Focus on responding to the prompt correctly to address the percent of students at zero
- Student peer editing
 - Focus on understanding the rubric to increase the students scoring 5 or higher
