Dates of Importance for the November 3, 2009 Referendum Elections:	
September 11, 2009	Last day to adopt resolution calling the referendum election.
September 11, 2009	Last day to notify county auditors and the Commissioner of the date of the election and the questions or offices to be voted on.
October 4, 2009	First day absentee ballots must be available for November election (30 days prior to election). Because this date falls on a Sunday, districts should have ballots available Friday, October 2.
October 4, 2009	First day District may mail required notice (no more than 30 days prior to election).
October 9, 2009	Last day to appoint election judges.
October 13, 2009	Last day to preregister for November election (at least 21 days prior to date of election).
October 19, 2009	Last day to mail required notice (at least 15 days prior to date of election).
October 19, 2009	Last day to provide copy of required notice to Commissioner of Education and county auditors (at least 15 days prior to date of election).
October 20, 2009	Last day to publish first notice of November election.
October 24, 2009	Last day to post notice of November election (at least 10 days prior to date of the election). Because this date falls on a Saturday, districts should post notice by Friday, October 23. Campaign finance reports are due.
October 27, 2009	Last day to publish second notice of November election.
October 30, 2009	Last day to post sample ballot of November election (at least 4 days prior to date of election).
November 2, 2009	Last day to apply for absentee ballot for November election (day prior to date of election).
November 3, 2009	Election day.
November 10, 2009	Last day to adopt resolution canvassing for November election.
15 days after canvass	Last day to notify Commissioner of results of election
