

**Dates of Importance for the  
November 3, 2009 Referendum Elections:**

<b>September 11, 2009</b>	Last day to adopt resolution calling the referendum election.
<b>September 11, 2009</b>	Last day to notify county auditors and the Commissioner of the date of the election and the questions or offices to be voted on.
<b>October 4, 2009</b>	First day absentee ballots must be available for November election (30 days prior to election). <b>Because this date falls on a Sunday, districts should have ballots available Friday, October 2.</b>
<b>October 4, 2009</b>	First day District may mail required notice (no more than 30 days prior to election).
<b>October 9, 2009</b>	<b>Last day to appoint election judges.</b>
<b>October 13, 2009</b>	Last day to preregister for November election (at least 21 days prior to date of election).
<b>October 19, 2009</b>	Last day to mail required notice (at least 15 days prior to date of election).
<b>October 19, 2009</b>	Last day to provide copy of required notice to Commissioner of Education and county auditors (at least 15 days prior to date of election).
<b>October 20, 2009</b>	Last day to publish first notice of November election.
<b>October 24, 2009</b>	Last day to post notice of November election (at least 10 days prior to date of the election). <b>Because this date falls on a Saturday, districts should post notice by Friday, October 23. Campaign finance reports are due.</b>
<b>October 27, 2009</b>	Last day to publish second notice of November election.
<b>October 30, 2009</b>	Last day to post sample ballot of November election (at least 4 days prior to date of election).
<b>November 2, 2009</b>	Last day to apply for absentee ballot for November election (day prior to date of election).
<b>November 3, 2009</b>	Election day.
<b>November 10, 2009</b>	Last day to adopt resolution canvassing for November election.
<b>15 days after canvass</b>	Last day to notify Commissioner of results of election
