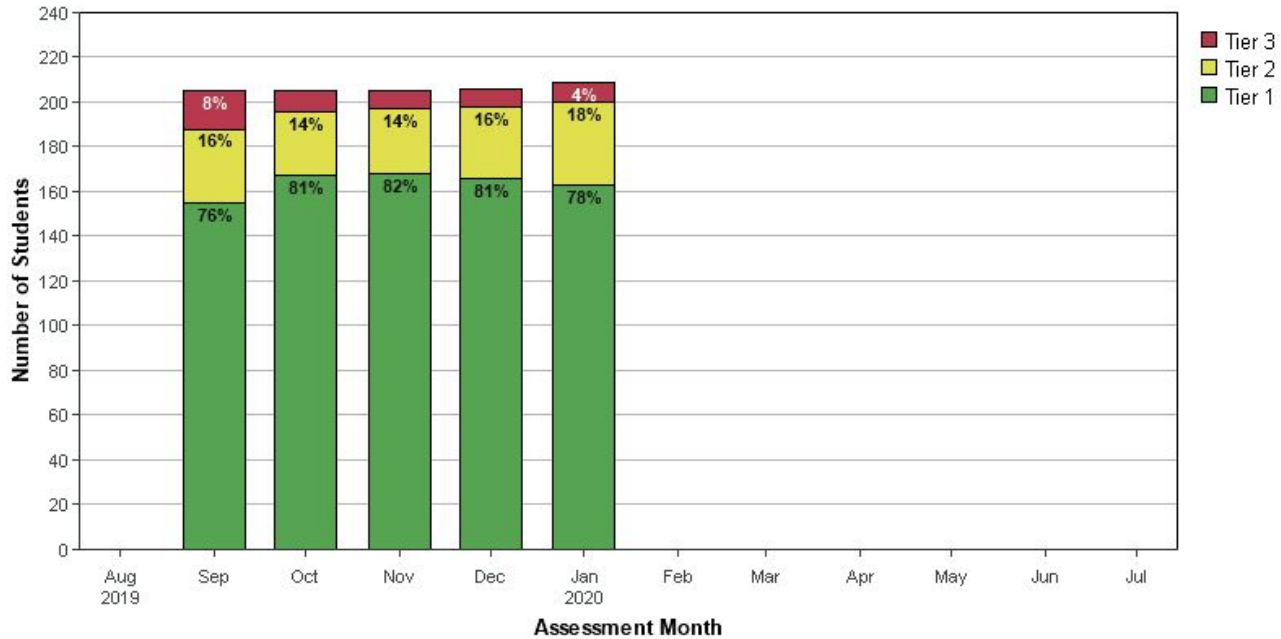

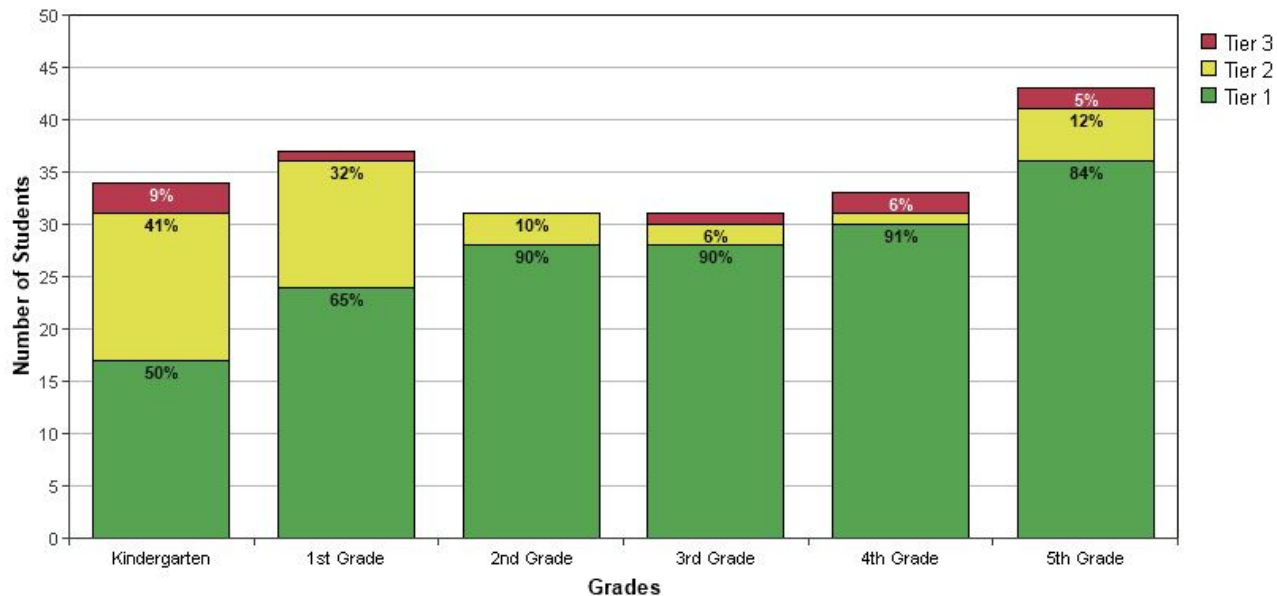

January Tier Movement for Istation Benchmarking- Math

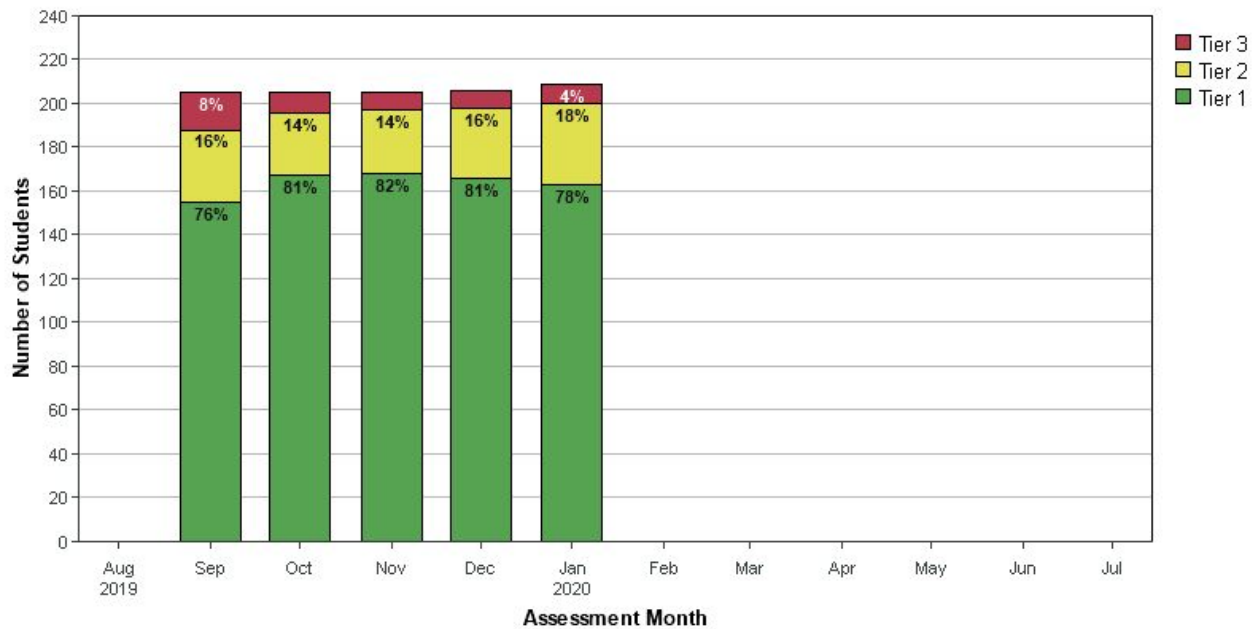
