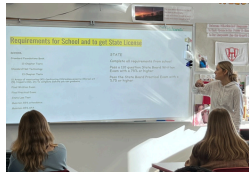


HHS 2ND SEMESTER 2024 HAPPENINGS

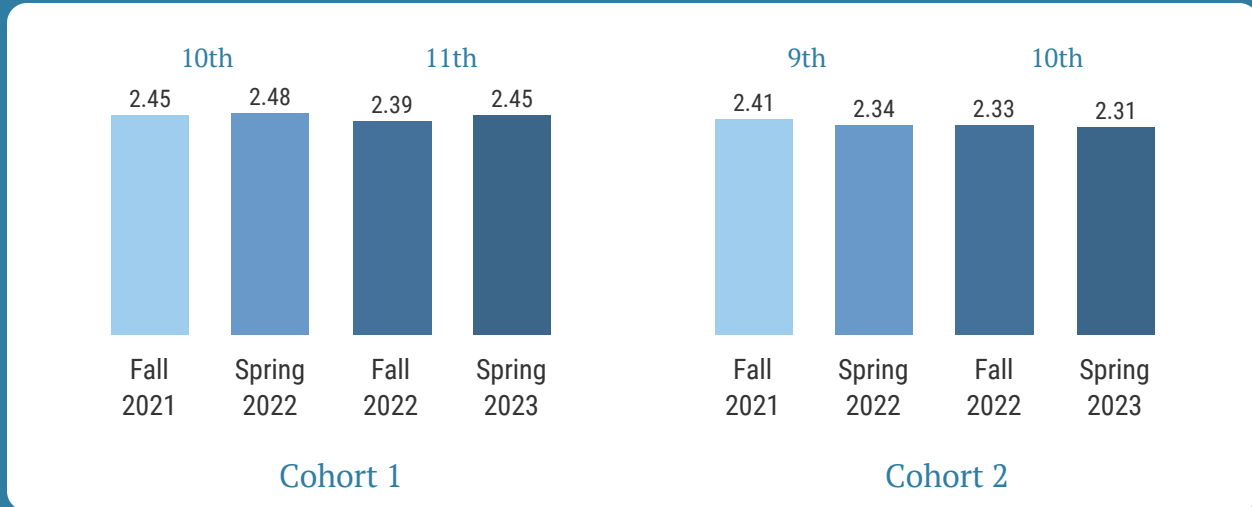

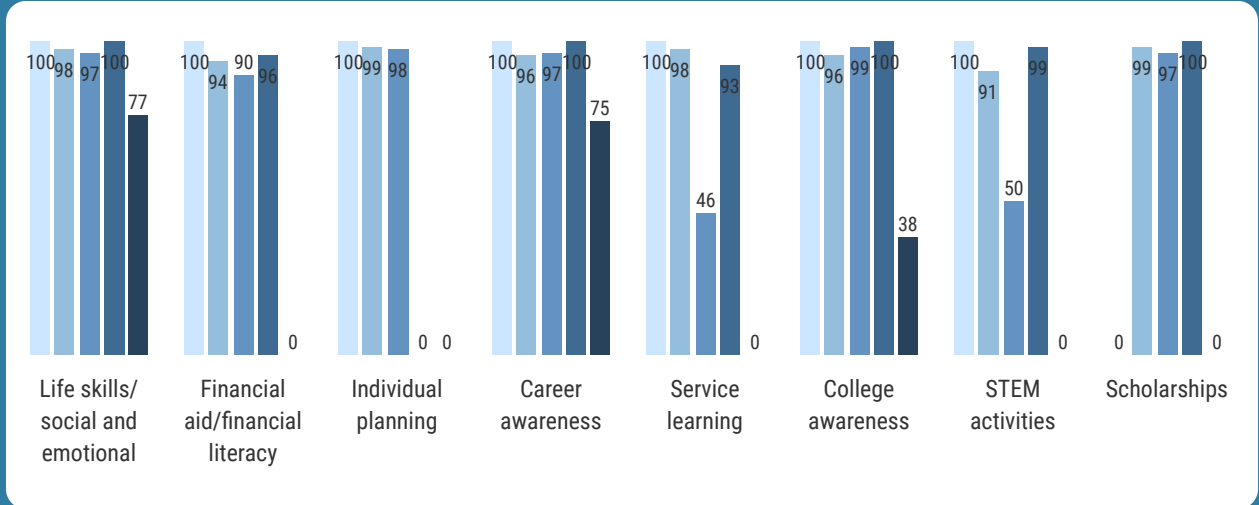
GEAR UP Participation

Student participation in GEAR UP activities, annually and cumulatively

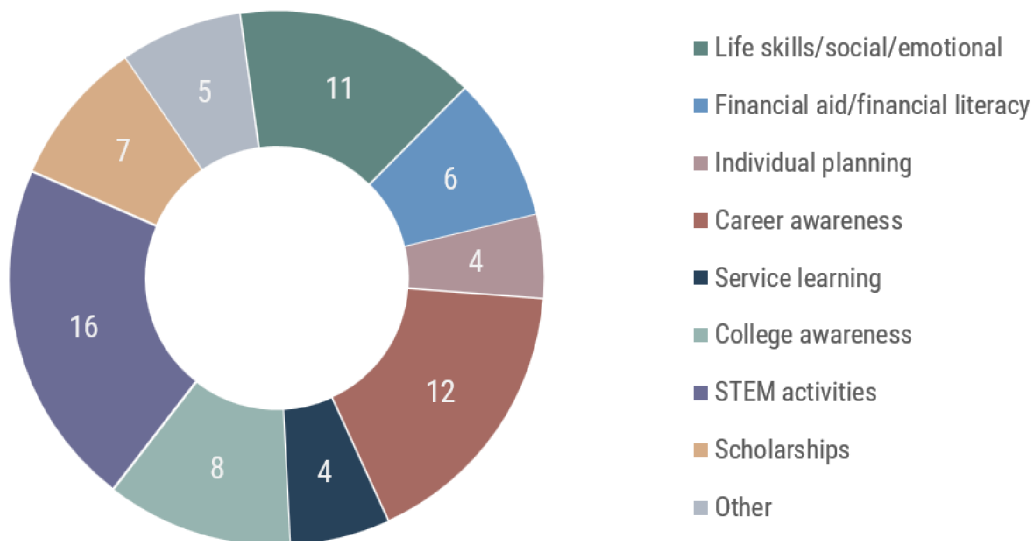


Homedale School District
