Good morning Mr. Taylor

My name is Crystal Curengton. I am currently active duty in the Arkansas National Guard. I reside at 1511 Hardin Road North, White Hall, AR 71602. I submitted an application online for my daughter KaLynn L. Hellums for school of choice at the White Hall School District on May 01, 2021. I later received a letter in the mail from the school district denying her due to the availability of 3rd graders for the district. I called the school district on June 21, 2021 to receive an explanation of her denial. The said person I spoke (I can't remember his name) stated that he was the person that approves/denies the application. I tried to explain my reasons of needing her to attend the school district there due to hardship of me having to report every morning at 0700 and her attending the Pine Bluff Arsenal Child Care Development Center as we speak. I explained that the center is willing to make transportation needs of her getting to school and picking her up for after school until I get off of work at 1530 every day. I explained I have to drive an hour and 15 minutes to make it work every day while my Administrative Officer explains the importance of me making it to work on time. He told me that if I was to move closer to the district, that she would be able to attend with no problem. He stated he was sorry and wished he could help, but the only way was for me to move closer. I did not know that I could appeal this decision. If I would've known, I would have made contact with your office as soon as I received the letter of denial. I have attached above, my current active duty commitment orders as well as my orders for JRTC training. Later, the Pine Bluff Arsenal Child Care Development Center Director (Mrs. Amber Webber) is submitting supporting documentation to show that their willing to provide transportation service for my daughter. I will be leaving for JRTC on June 06, 2021 to August 07, 2021 at Ft. Polk, Louisiana. I will be out of reach during training from (July 17 - July 26). If you know a date of possible zoom meeting or court ordered meeting, that will be great to know to report it to my Administrative Officer for tracking purposes. I greatly appreciate your time and support.

I will submit the letter of denial as soon as I return home from work today.
