<b>Action</b>	Discuss, consider, and approve the library catalogs and procurement lists for all Crosby ISD campuses.
<b>Motion</b>	I move to approve the library catalogs and procurement lists for all Crosby ISD campuses.
<b>Administrative Recommendation</b>	The Crosby ISD Administration recommends approving the library catalogs and procurement lists for all Crosby ISD campuses.
<b>Authority for this Action</b>	Board Policy, EFB(LEGAL)
<b>Goal/Objective Addressed</b>	District Goal 1: Student Achievement Crosby ISD will ensure that every student achieves their full academic potential by providing high-quality instruction, engaging learning opportunities, and a supportive environment that prepares all learners for success in an ever-changing world.
<b>Background</b>	<p>Senate Bill 13 strengthens statutory requirements governing public school library materials. The law enhances parental rights by providing access to district library catalogs and permitting parents to restrict their child’s access to specific materials.</p> <p>During the 89<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislative Session, SB13 was amended to expand and clarify district responsibilities related to school library materials. These updates include enhanced transparency requirements for library catalogs, strengthened provisions ensuring parental access to information about available materials, and formalized procedures allowing parents to restrict their child’s access to specific resources. The legislation also reinforces standards for the acquisition, review, and removal of library materials to ensure age-appropriate content and compliance with state law.</p> <p>Under EFB(LOCAL), the board shall either approve or reject the library materials that have been donated or proposed for procurement.</p> <p>Library catalogs and procurement lists can be accessed at the link below: <a href="https://www.crosbyisd.org/departments/curriculum-and-instruction/library-services/library-materials">https://www.crosbyisd.org/departments/curriculum-and-instruction/library-services/library-materials</a></p>

<b>Budget Information</b>	Approval of the library catalogs and procurement lists will authorize campuses and librarians to acquire resources in accordance with the approved selections.
<b>Impact of this Action</b>	The Boards approval strengthens student learning by ensuring campus library materials are intentionally selected, reviewed, and maintained to support curriculum objectives, literacy development, and age-appropriate inquiry. Clear standards and review processes promote high-quality resources that reinforce classroom instruction, foster critical thinking, and encourage independent reading. By aligning collection decisions with educational relevance and community expectations, this action enhances instructional coherence and supports improved student engagement and academic growth across grade levels.
