AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) is the system of measuring of student achievement created by NCLB (No Child Left Behind). I wish to present the results for the 2010-2011 school year.

Since 2002, NCLB has been in effect and has gradually raised the criteria for the percentage of students meeting or exceeding in math and reading/language arts. This past year saw the percentage rise to 70% in both areas for a school to meet AYP in all subgroups. In addition, the ODE raised the cut scores in math to further increase the difficulty in meeting or exceeding. Reading cut scores were just raised and will be in effect this year. Congress continues to debate a new national education act that will most certainly throw out this form of measurement and lead to a more individual progress monitoring system of accountability.
