 - i. 2 sections of Intermediate Algebra (9th Grade) & 3 Sections of Geometry ((th & 10th Grade)
 - Math Department will be working for 3 days
 - i. 1 day data review and best practice discussions
 - ii. 2 days of coordinating curriculum and lessons to assessments to state standards
 - English Language Arts Department will be working for 3 days
 - i. 1 day Reader's Choice Workshop
 - ii. 1 day data review and best practices discussions
 - iii. 1 day curriculum coordinating and assessment writing
 - Intervention Opportunities
 - i. 7th Grade
 - 7th Grade reading class is a semester class that focuses on providing students with reading strategies and increase their exposure to grade level reading materials
 - ii. 7th & 8th Grade
 - 1. Tiger block math & English class that meets every other day and spends part of the time pre-teaching upcoming lessons and part of the time reinforcing what is already being learned

- Pull out classes ½ half of a class period every day with a teacher or paraprofessional addressing more significant skills gaps
- iii. 9th-12th Grade
 - Math and Reading applications class that meets every day to both pre-teach upcoming lessons and reinforce their daily lessons, which are targeted at 9th grade students
 - 2. 9th grade seminar meets every day and helps students develop good study skills and organize their time
 - 3. Honors research class is a semester long class that allows students to receive enrichment curriculum in an area of their interests.
