Re: Athletic Director Report February, 2016

Winter sports season are entering crunch time. As the girls basketball teams enter district tournament play our boys basketball and wrestling teams are concluding their conference competition in preparation for district tournaments.

Girls Basketball - The program is well represented entering the District tournaments. All the hard work and commitment has paid off as they all enter the district tournaments with very high seeds. The Varsity enters the tournament as the #2 seed behind Emmett and with a win in its first game of the tournament would punch their ticket to the state tournament for a 4th straight season. The JV team enters the District tournament as the #1 seed with a record of 17- 4 and 9-1 in conference. The Frosh/Soph team has a record of 15 - 1 and Undefeated 10 – 0 in conference as they head into the district tournament as a 1st seed. The program is a combined 49-9 and 28-2 in conference going into district tournaments. Varsity tournament is Feb 4, 5, 9, and 11 at TVCC while the Lower level tournament is Feb 1, 2, and 3 at Weiser. State tournament is Feb 18-20 at Middleton High School.

Boys basketball - Currently the boys sit at Varsity- 11-6, JV at 14-3, and Frosh/Soph at 11-3. The fast paced tempo that the program has developed has proven very successful against sometimes larger and taller competition. The Varsity team just beat Fruitland last weekend at home. Lower Level District tournament is Feb 15, 17 and 19 in Fruitland. Varsity District tournament is Feb 16, 20, 23 and 25 at TVCC. State tournament is March 3rd-5th at Meridian High School.

Wrestling - Currently the team is 9-5 in duals and 1-2 in conference duals. Last weekend Nash Johnson and his parents braved the roads to Sugar Salem and became Tournament Champion. We are looking forward to our February matches. SRV districts on Feb 20th. State Wrestling will take place Feb 26th and 27th in Pocatello.
