1) School Enrollment (K-4/Lifeskills) as of 6/12/17

- a. Student Count- 370 total (11 in Lifeskills)
- b. Class sizes-
 - i. k-18,19,19 (56 total + 1 Lifeskill student)
 - ii. 1st- 27,28,28 (83 total + 2 Lifeskill students)
 - iii. 2nd- 23,23,24 (70 total + 1 Lifeskill student)
 - iv. 3rd- 21,22,23 (66 total + 5 Lifeskill students)
 - v. 4th- 27,27,28 (83 total + 3 Lifeskill students)

2) Boys and Girls update (Jenna Larkin)

- a. On average, 70-100 increase for daily attendance
 - i. 80-90 elementary
- b. Teen nights a SUCCESS
 - i. 2nd and 4th Fridays every month; 7:00-9:00pm (Ages 12-18)
 - ii. 4 staff/3 volunteers
 - iii. Dodgeball/Volleyball/DJ-music
 - iv. Attendance= 60 or higher (94 last one)
- c. Summer hours are 7:30-6:30pm
 - i. June 19th to August 18th

3) **End of year DIBELS** Composite Data (Tawnya Campbell)

- a. kinder= 50% CORE (+13% from September)
- b. 1st grade= 42% CORE (+23% from September)
- c. 2nd grade= 53% CORE (+1 % from September)
- d. 3rd grade= 48% CORE (+7% from September)
- e. 4th grade= 54% CORE (+13% from September)

4) **PBIS SCHOOLWIDE DATA** for the year (Comparisons from previous year)- similar enrollment numbers, approx. 375 students

- a. 589 **trackers schoolwide** (2015-16) vs. 508 trackers (2016-17)
 - i. **Down 14%**
- b. 311 **trackers** (2015-16) **in class** vs. 279 trackers (2016-17)
 - i. **Down 10%**
- c. 143 **trackers** (2015-16) **at recess** vs. 100 trackers (2016-17)
 - i. **Down 30 %**
- d. **Referrals** (Principal Intervention)
 - i. 210 (2015-16) vs. 170 (2016-17)
 - a. **Down 19%**
