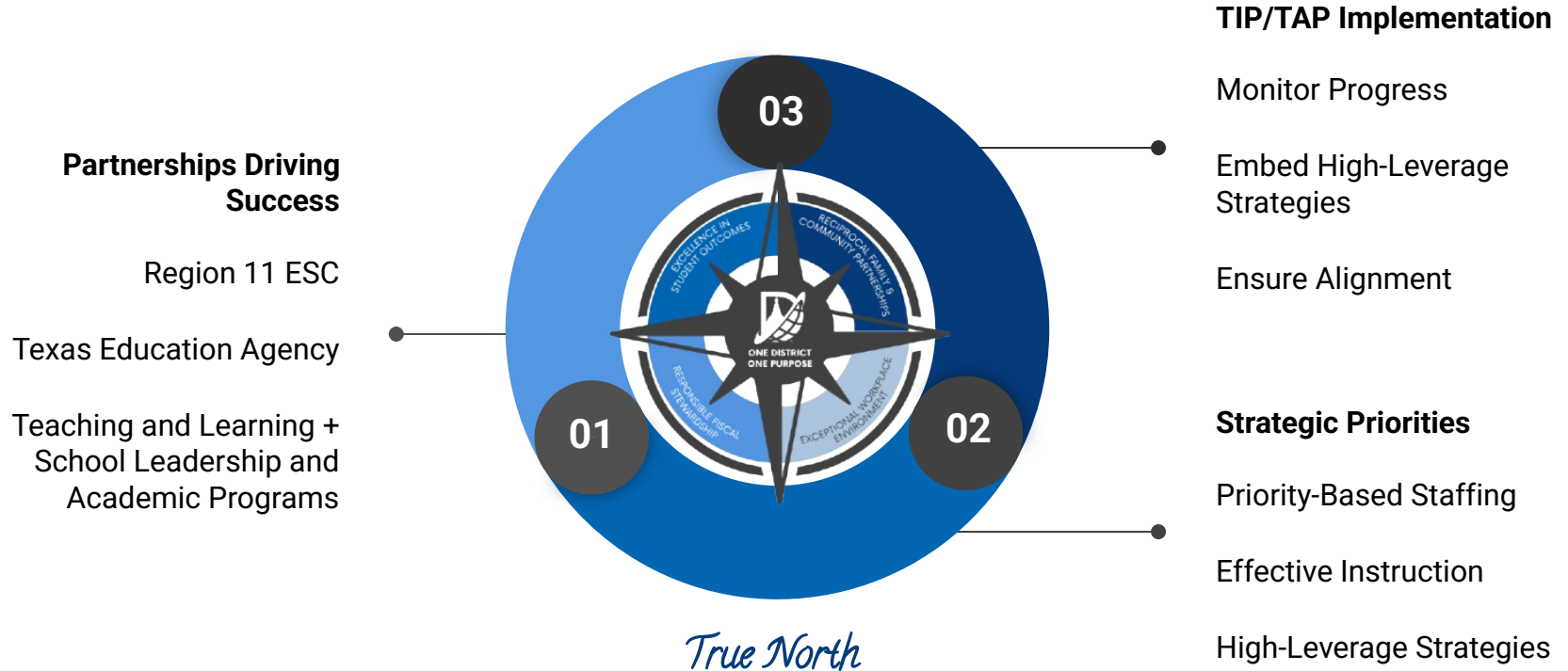

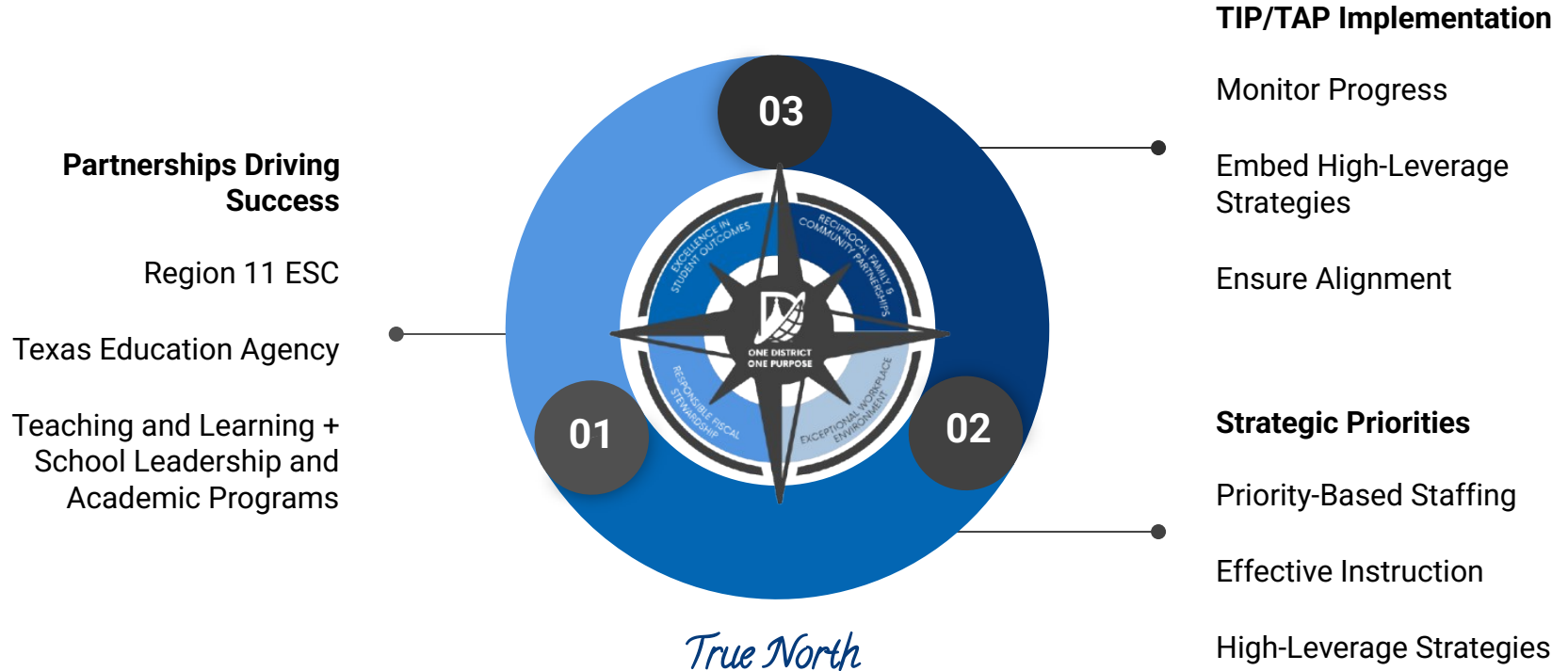


School Improvement Process
