		deficiencies were unanticipated and only discovered

		interior. Neither of these issues were sufficiently		
		funded in the original project budget or contingency		
		allowance. This request covers the costs associated		
		with these unforeseen and urgent needs to ensure the		
		continued safety, functionality, and compliance of
